There may be problems in your day-to-day life that affect your child's health and well being. These problems can make health problems more serious or difficult to handle if not taken care of in a timely manner. Project HEAL at KKI provides advocacy and legal services to help children, adolescents, and their families, who receive health care services at KKI. Project HEAL at KKI offers FREE advocacy and legal services on many issues, including:

- Special Education & Related Services
- Public Benefits
- Landlord/Tenant Problems
- School suspension
- Social Security
- Adult Guardianship
- Family law
- Name
- Deed changes
- Wills
- Tax disputes & tax preparation
- Other legal issues

What is the cost of Project HEAL at KKI?

Project HEAL at KKI services are FREE of charge. You will not receive a bill for any advice or services. However, if there are any court costs or filing fees associated with your legal matter, you are responsible for those fees.

Am I eligible for Project HEAL at KKI?

Project HEAL at KKI provides advocacy and legal services to any child, adolescent, or family that receives health care services at KKI, whose family meets the income eligibility guidelines of MVLS.

How to use Project HEAL at KKI

1. Need help with special education and related services? Public Benefits? Housing? Family Law? Other advocacy and legal issues? If you are a patient or a family member of a patient, who receives health care services from KKI, then YOU should contact Project HEAL at KKI. Otherwise, your doctor, psychologist, psychiatrist, nurse practitioner, nurse, or social worker may refer you to Project HEAL at KKI if you have advocacy or legal issues.
2. Speak to the Director of Project HEAL at KKI about your advocacy or legal issues and receive FREE services.
3. If your advocacy or legal issue falls within an area that Project HEAL at KKI does not handle, your case may be referred to MVLS for placement with a pro bono lawyer.
4. Services from Project HEAL at KKI are available from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
